Tickets

Tickets will be \$22.00 each and will be sold ONLINE ONLY **Ticket sales will begin on Monday, April 20th at 6 pm.** You will NOT receive physical tickets but will either print or download them on your phones.

Measurement Week:

December 8th through December 13th will be Costume Measurement Week. All dancers will be measured for their costumes in their class. It is very important to make every effort to have your dancer in class during this week. We cannot accurately order costumes without this information. Please let the desk know if you have missed that week, or if your dancer has not been measured, so we can take care of that before we leave for winter break.

**We also request clothing size on the form if a student isn't physically available for a measurement.

Backstage Moms

We will only allow you to be backstage if we know that you are a mom who will help all children, not just your own.

Please don't be offended by this, it is to make sure all dancers are well taken care of. We are looking for moms to help children be entertained and happy, go potty, get changed, get in formation, etc. You must be able and willing to work in a fast-paced environment with lots of tiny dancers. There will be a backstage mom sign up form available with the recital handbook emailed in March.

Recital Week/Last Week of Classes

Recital week includes a **mandatory** dress rehearsal listed above. Dress rehearsal is not optional – it is mandatory (we cannot stress this enough). Those not at the dress rehearsal, will **not** be permitted to participate in the recital. In summary, there are 2 mandatory dates - dress rehearsal and your applicable show date (all listed above). Your rehearsal will go in the order of your show. Once finished at dress rehearsal, dancers are free to leave. At the recital, dancers stay for the entirety of the show and are dismissed immediately following the finale. During dress rehearsal, parents will be responsible for changing their dancers.

We ask that dancers **bring their costumes to class** the last week of classes and come with their hair and make-up done with the correct tights and shoes. We will do their dance once in costume so their instructor can approve that hair, tights, and costume is correct. They will then take a class photo and have our end-of-year celebration.

Recital Details:

We pride ourselves in putting on the biggest and best shows possible for your families. They look forward to it all year and work very hard! It creates great memories year after year. We hope you will be able to experience it with us!

PLEASE be on time for your stated arrival time. The show starts promptly at the time shown, and we cannot hold or stop the show because of lateness.

- Children 1 year or younger are permitted to sit on a parent's lap, with the knowledge that they will not be able to use a seat.
- No parents are permitted backstage during the recital unless you are a backstage mom - This is for the safety of the dancers, our faculty, staff and parent volunteers.
- At dress rehearsal, parents stay with their dancers until they are finished and are free to go once, they have finished.
- At the recital, the **dancers stay backstage for the full show and come back out at the end.** They are then dismissed from youngest to oldest. This is **VERY** important to remember and understand.
- Picture information will be given at a later date.

Hair:

Pre-Kinder Dance, Tot Hop* - **Pigtails**

Kinder Dance - **Ponytail**

Junior B and older- **High bun center of the head no part.**

Tot hop, Little Lyrical, Tiny Pom and Broadway Babies will follow the hairstyle of your ballet (kinder/pre kinder) class; if NOT in ballet – **Ponytail

Tights:

Kinder dance and younger - Pink tights for all dances. (this includes tot hop)

Junior B and older – Pink tights for ballet, tan for all other dances

Reminder to our Pre-Pro and Pro dancers: At the absolute **minimum**, ballet, jazz, and lyrical performances are required in the annual recital. Dancers in Advanced Musical Theater are also expected to perform in the annual recital. All Encore Elite team members are required to perform, at a minimum, ballet, jazz, and lyrical in the annual recital. This requirement is also stated in your competition handbook and the contract.
